

End of Day (or Departure) Protocol

(Note: any private remediation shall be done at the conclusion of the dismissal of the other training attendees.)

The following applies to those who are being dismissed from training, not to any training participants subject to Remediation. Those subject to Remediation shall be sequestered during the following procedures. Training Staff involved in the Remediation shall also be sequestered during the following general End of Day Protocol.

If no Remedial training is required, all persons in attendance shall undergo the following procedures.

- Retrieval and inventory of all training devices
- Retrieval and inventory of all PPE
- Injury reporting
- Unsafe training facility reporting
- Unsafe Trainer reporting
- Removal of all SCIs from personnel, bags, vehicles, etc.
- End of Training Declaration
- Return of any sequestered items from Black Box
- READY inspection (mutual gear checks to ensure no duty gear contains training devices)
- Questions
- Staff debrief
- Gear inventory and break down of training location if necessary
- Closing of Training Plan with any agencies that had been contacted

End of Training Declaration:

Training is OVER. From this point on, any devices in any of your operational gear are assumed to be operational and have the capacity to cause ACTUAL harm. There shall be no “do overs” or “let’s try this one more time” events. If any other training issues need to be addressed, they must be addressed through direct discussion and permission of the Safety Officer, who, at their sole discretion, shall determine the necessary safety protocols required to adequately address the issue. There shall be NO type of simulation or synthetic recreation of any type of use of force event without re-commencing the Safety Protocols required as if it were the beginning of a new training session.
